

TOBACCO-FREE ENVIRONMENT

School district facilities and school grounds, including school vehicles, shall be off limits for tobacco products, look alike, and their use, including the use of nicotine products that are not FDA (Food and Drug Administration) approved for tobacco cessation. This requirement extends to employees, students, and visitors. This policy applies at all times, including school-sponsored and non-school-sponsored events. Persons failing to abide by this policy shall be required to extinguish their smoking material, dispose of the tobacco/nicotine product, or leave the school district premises immediately. It shall be the responsibility of the administration to enforce this policy.
